### *Making Disciples...*

## *Go and Make Disciples*

*“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” — (Matthew 28:19-20).*

The final word that Jesus tells His disciples is to go and make disciples. Why do you think Jesus is concerned about making disciples? It is because His mission was “to seek and save the lost” and to make disciples who followed His teachings and the example He showed in His life. We tend to think of discipleship as the process of teaching and learning the Scriptures. While that is true, Jesus’ statement in Matthew 28 involves evangelism (making new disciples) and instruction in discipleship or growing disciples.

#### **The Culture of Discipleship.**

Jesus said, “Go, therefore, and make disciples...” He expressed an attitude that is an ongoing process. It is not a go and check the boxes

and move on to something else. The life of a disciple is always looking to the standard of God's word and making the changes needed to be in keeping with the standard. Yes, new disciples are sought after and must be taught to accept the teachings of Christ. Still, it will follow as a lifelong attitude or the culture of the way disciples live.

### Focus on Making Disciples.

This year, we will focus on making disciples. In doing so, we look to cultivate the culture of discipleship in our lives. In this culture, we will always seek ways to bring others to know about Jesus and what He has done for them. We will be looking at our lives endeavoring to walk more like Jesus.

As we go through this year, let us develop the culture of discipleship and focus on making disciples for Jesus, ourselves, and others. In thinking about the theme of discipleship, may the song written by Thomas O. Chisholm be our prayer:

*O to be like Thee! Blessed Redeemer;  
This is my constant longing and prayer;  
Gladly, I'll forfeit all of earth's treasures,  
Jesus, Thy perfect likeness to wear,*

*O to be like Thee! full of compassion,  
Loving, forgiving, tender, and kind,  
Helping the helpless, cheering the fainting,  
Seeking the wandering sinner to find.*

*O to be like Thee! Lowly in spirit,  
Holy and harmless, patient and brave;  
Meekly enduring cruel reproaches,  
Willing to suffer, others to save.*

*O to be like Thee! Lord, I am coming,

## Looking Forward With Joy

Snow means different things to different people. For some, snow days are about shoveling driveways and tricky commutes. For others, snow means e-learning and Zoom classes. However, for another group, snow is all about wonder and winter activities. My three little girls definitely fall into the latter category; they love to play in God's winter wonderland, making snowmen, snow angels, and engaging in the occasional snowball fight. They also love to sled. Unfortunately, our property is about as flat as a pancake, which doesn't make for very good sledding. That usually means my girls will beg me to take them to a few places in town with good hills.

This all played out recently. The snow came, the girls were anxious to go sledding, and unfortunately, I was busy. But after some additional prompting, I committed. You should have seen the girls' reaction; they went from being anxious about possibly not getting to go to looking forward to the event (read jumping up and down) – and all because they believed I would make good on my word! When we reached the appointed time, we all piled into the van in our snow gear, and the girls had a blast.

I think there's a spiritual lesson here for us. In Scripture, God promises that Christians will join Him in heaven. 1 Thessalonians 5:9-11 reads: "For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with Him. Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing."

The verb translated "destined" means, "to destine or appoint someone to or for something." Biblically, the word "destiny" is used regularly to describe God's determination of events. In other words, if God says it will happen - we should believe it! There is indeed wrath coming for all who are unbelieving and disobedient, but not for God's faithful. Paul goes out of his way to tell the Christians at Thessalonica (and therefore us) that God has **not** destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through Jesus.

Just like I made an appointment with my girls to

take them sledding, in Christ God has made us a divine appointment. If we are faithful to the end, God has destined us for salvation; it is His will and His desire. Therefore, we need to be encouraging each other with these words! Just like my girls looked forward to their appointment on the sledding hill, we should look forward to our eternal destination. In fact, my kids spent the next few days gleefully talking with each other about their upcoming appointment with "Dad", and as God's children, we should be doing the same. I hope you look forward with joy to being with our Father throughout eternity; I know I do!
